Thailand

Located in Southeast Asia, Thailand is a country that has never been colonized. It recognizes its traditional 'founding' date as 1238, with a long history (13th through 18th centuries) of Thai kingdoms seeking to establish stability in a region of conflict both within its borders and across borders with Burma, Cambodia, Laos, and the Malay Peninsula. In the 1890's and 1900's, the British and French forced the northern Siamese kingdom to cede Cambodian, Laotian, and Malay territories that had been under its control. It was established as a constitutional monarchy in 1932. There have been numerous bloodless coups and the exchange of power between military and bureaucratic authorities throughout its modern history. In 1954, Thailand became a US treaty ally, sending troops to Korea, and fighting alongside the US in Vietnam. The work of the Church of the Nazarene in Thailand began in 1989 through the generous giving of the Japan District Church of the Nazarene, and WEF giving around the world. Today, Thailand is dealing with an aging population, a shrinking workforce, and increased internal migration and foreign immigration from neighboring countries. This presents new challenges and opportunities for ministry.
